Winter Parking Ordinance Ordinance No. 120

STATE OF WISCONSIN Town of Mentor Clark County

The Town Board for the Town of Mentor, Clark County, Wisconsin do hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. Winter Parking

- (a) Winter Emergency Parking Restrictions. No person shall park any vehicle within five (5) feet of the paved area along any Town of Mentor street or road where parking during a winter removal emergency has been prohibited as set forth in paragraph (b) below. The Town Chairperson may proclaim a winter removal emergency and prohibit the parking of vehicles at such times and in such areas as would impede snow removal operations.
- (b) Prohibited Parking During Winter Removal Emergency. There shall be no parking within five (5) feet of the paved area of any Town of Mentor street or road after a winter removal emergency has been proclaimed by the Town Chairperson.
- (c) Definition. For purposes of this section a winter removal emergency is defined as a snow fall of three (3) inches or more, an accumulation of ice or when the Town Chairperson may otherwise declare a winter removal emergency.
- (d) Parking prohibited. There shall be no parking within five (5) feet of the paved area along any Town of Mentor street or road between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. from December 1 through April 1 of the following year.
- (e) *Penalty*. Any person who violates this section shall forfeit not less than \$10.00 or more than \$25.00. Each day, or partial day, of continued violation shall constitute a separate offense. In addition, without limiting the authority of the Town to impose the forfeiture, the Town may cause a vehicle parked in violation of this ordinance to be towed.

Adopted this 14th day of December, 2010.

EFFECTIVE DATE. Pursuant to Wis. Stats. \S 60.80 this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon publication.
