STATE OF WISCONSIN TOWN OF MENTOR CLARK COUNTY

Parking & Trash Bin Restrictions Ordinance No. 134

The Town Board for the Town of Mentor, Clark County, Wisconsin do hereby ordain as follows:

Parking prohibited in specified places. No operator of a vehicle shall park or leave standing a vehicle in any of the following places except to comply with the directions of a traffic officer or traffic control signal or sign:

- 1. General Restrictions
 - a. Any parked vehicles should be positioned in such a manner as to not block, obstruct, or impede emergency vehicle traffic.
 - b. No parking on any portion of a street when such portion is properly designated by an official "no parking" sign.
 - c. No parking in or in front of any private driveway without the permission of the owner.
 - d. No parking in or blocking alleys.
 - e. No parking within 15ft of an alley entrance or intersection.
- 2. Winter Restrictions
 - a. Effective Dec 1st Mar 31st
 - b. During periods of expected snow falls of 3" or more
 - 1. Vehicles parked in the path of snow removal equipment need to be removed from the road, until snow removal is completed.
 - 2. Vehicles parked in a manner that prevents or impedes snow removal shall be removed at the owner's expense.

3. Trash Bin Restrictions. Trash bins should be left out no earlier than 24 hours prior to being collected. Empty trash containers should be removed no later than 24 hours after collection. No person shall leave trash containers whether Full or Empty on the road within the pathways of vehicles.

Penalty. Any person who violates this section shall forfeit \$50.00 for the 1st violation, \$100.00 for the 2nd violation, and \$200.00 for the 3rd and each subsequent violation. Each day, or partial day, of continued violation shall constitute a separate offense. In addition, without limiting the authority of the Town to impose the forfeiture, the Town may cause a vehicle parked in violation of this ordinance to be towed at owner's expense.

Adopted this 9th day of May 2023.

EFFECTIVE DATE. Pursuant to Wis. stats. 60.80 this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon publication.
